You know that feeling you get when someone makes you a big promise? You probably feel excited, but you might feel a little skeptical too — especially when that promise gets delayed . . . and delayed again . . . and again. If you have to wait long enough for something you were promised, you might start to wonder when you've waited long enough. Eventually, you might even give up hope. - If a friend said they weren't sure God heard their prayers, how would you encourage them? Did you need to hear any of the advice we just shared?
- Read I John 5:14-15. God hears every prayer, but do you think God answers every prayer? Why or why not?
- This week, what's something you're going to talk to God about more often?
